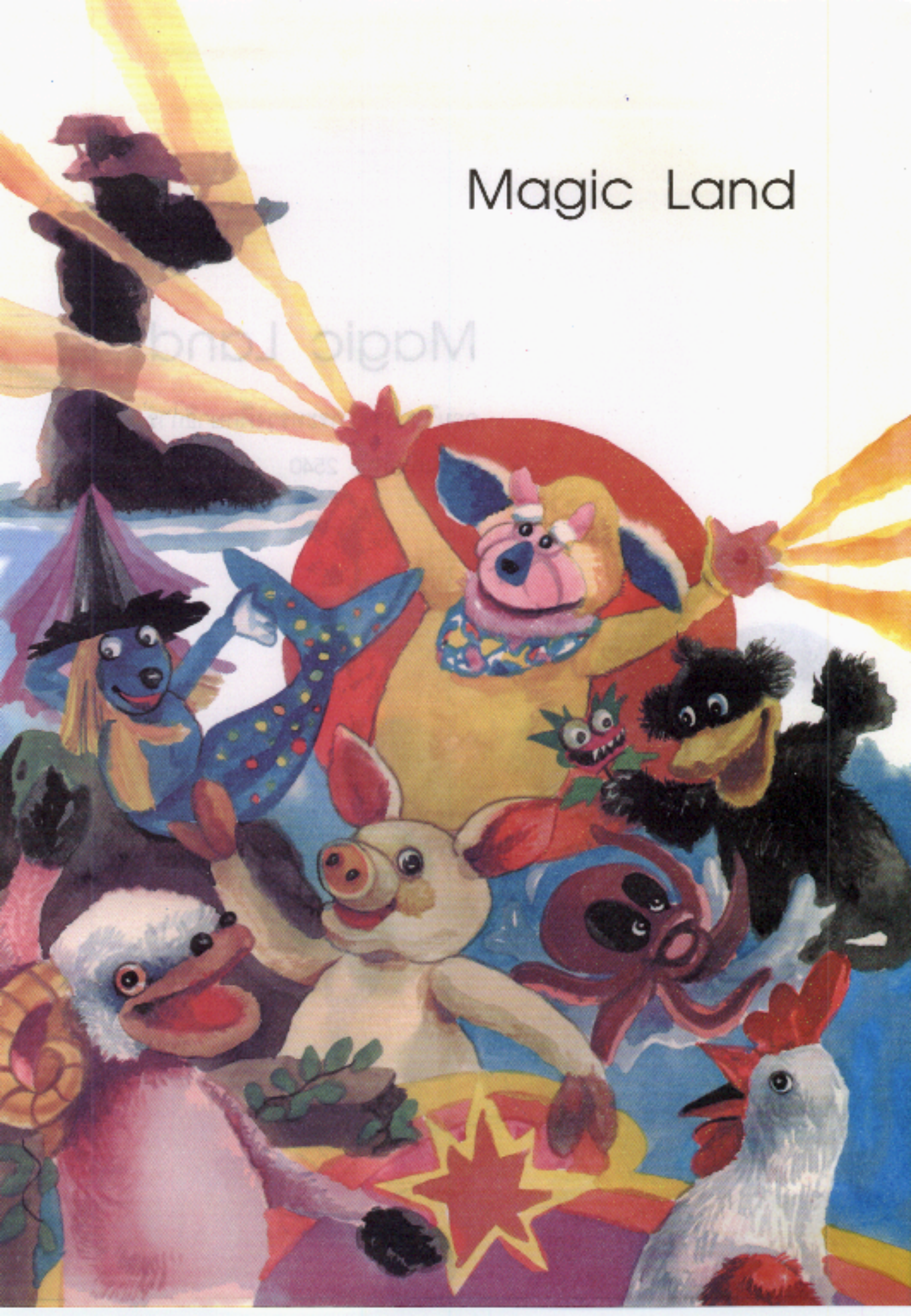

I'll go down this way.



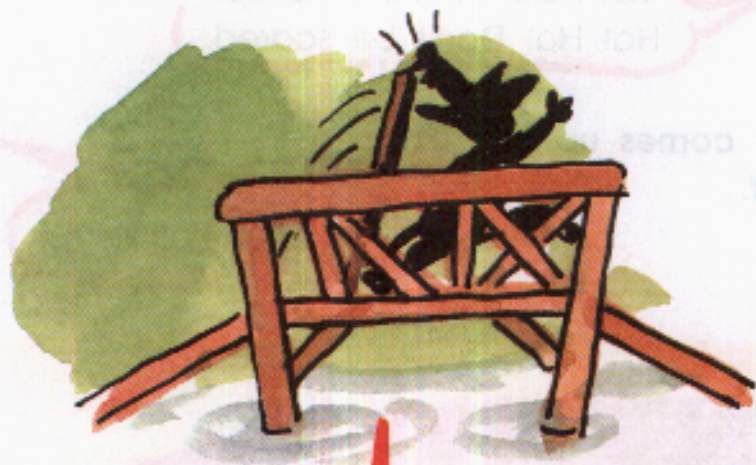
Ducky

Bird





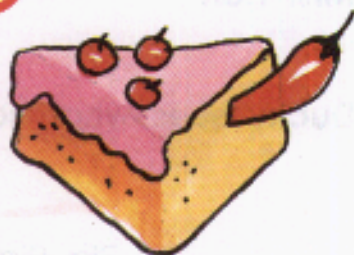
Ducky

Oh, that is a lamp.



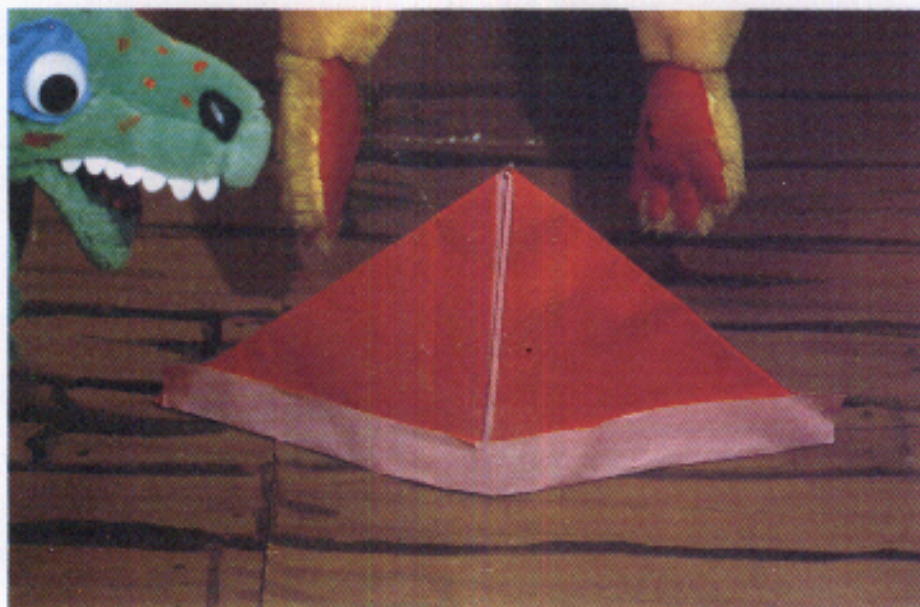
And this? What's this?

Crocodile

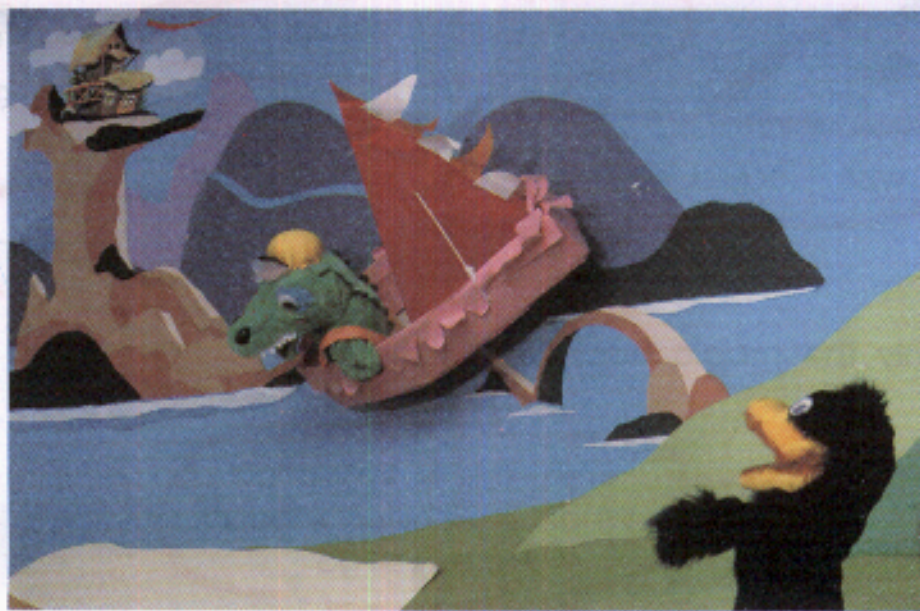
Just wait. I'm so hungry.

At Gump's house, Gump tries to help Ducky by making Ducky's boat fly.



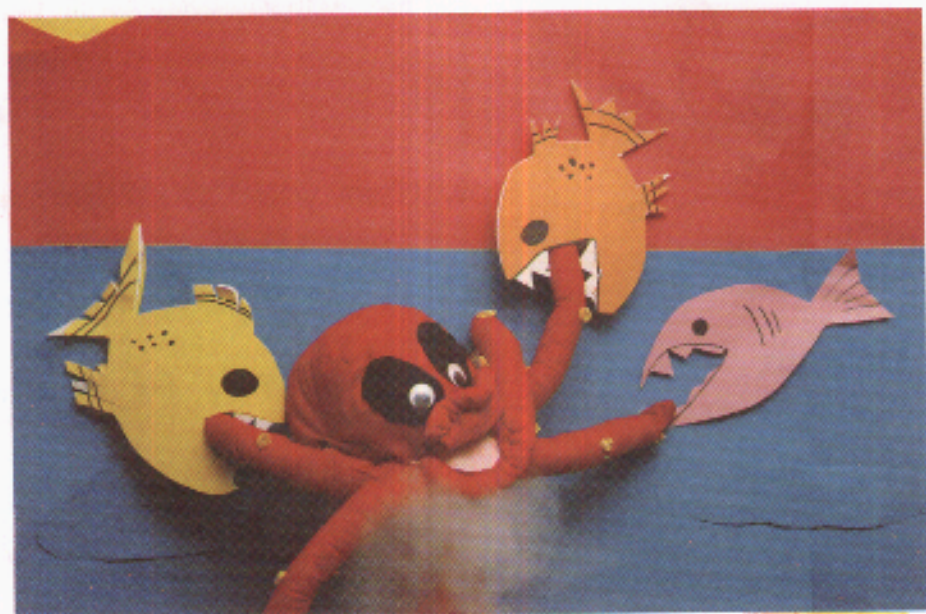
*Abacadabra, hocus-pocus,

Can you help me?



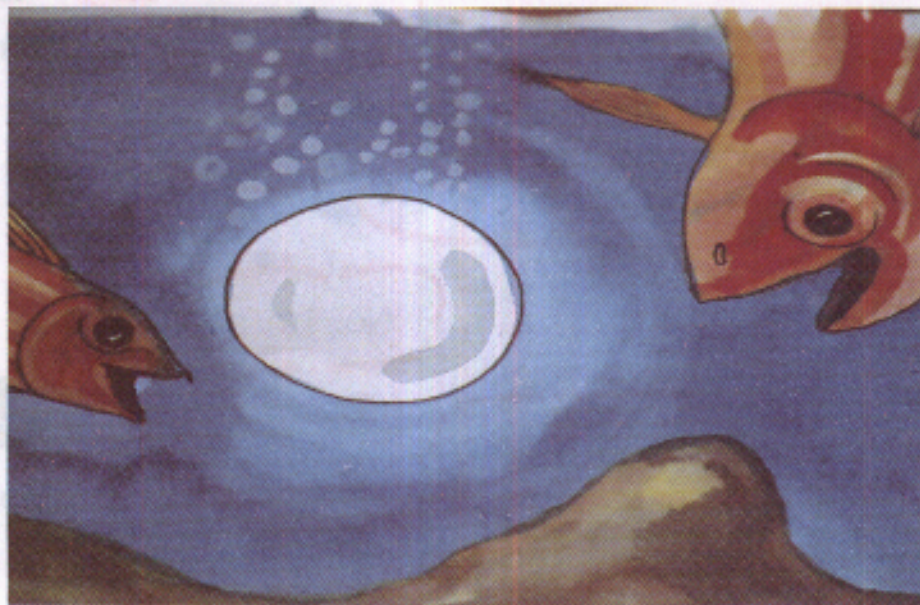
Octopus

You are a stupid octopus!

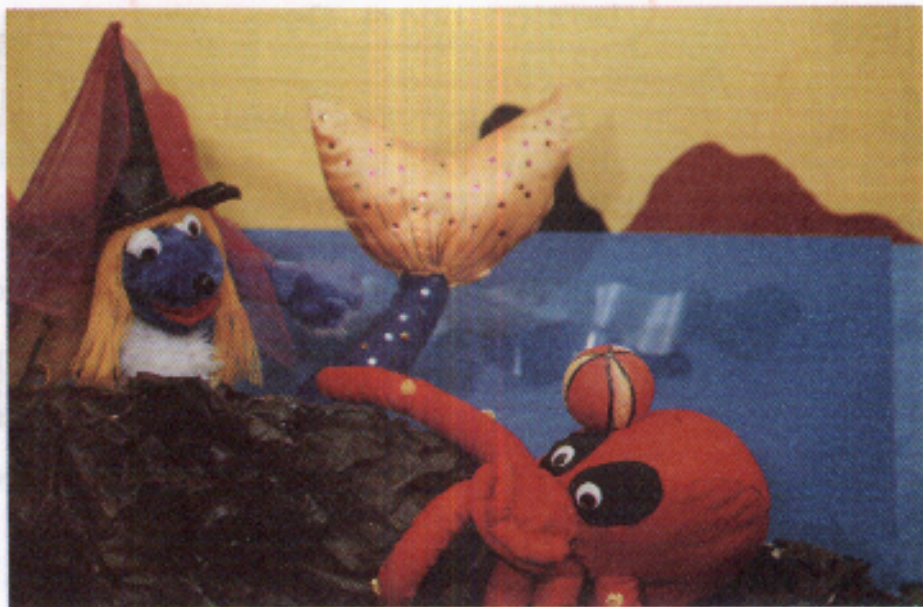


Mermaid

Ducky sees a lovely flower.

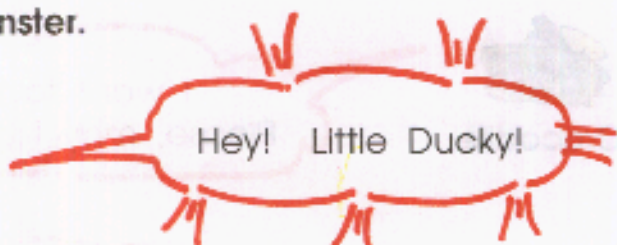

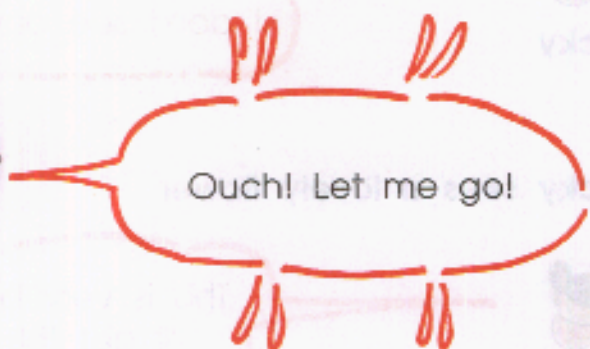
This is very beautiful.

What are you doing?

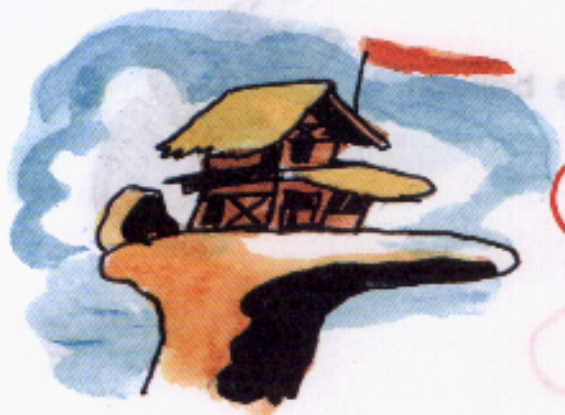

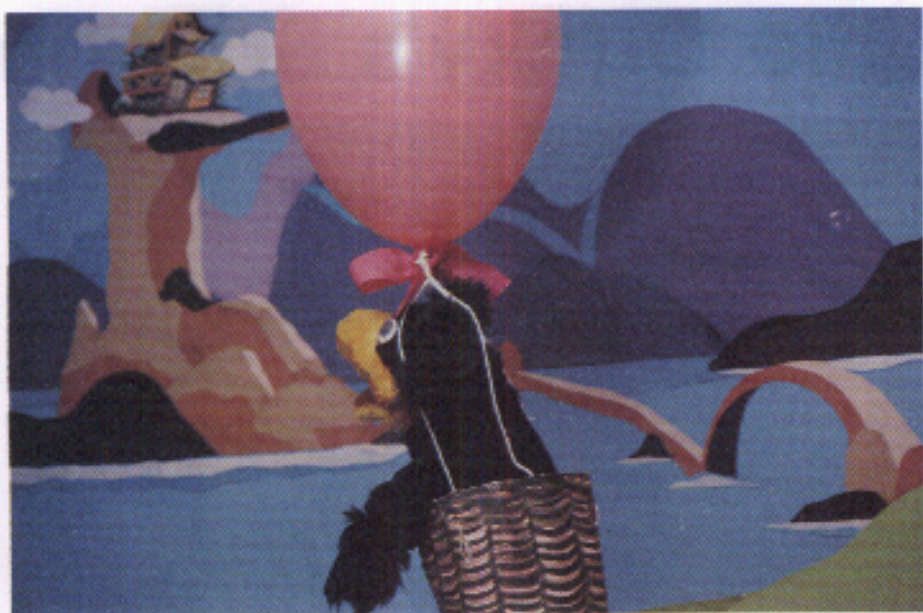
I'm making a balloon.

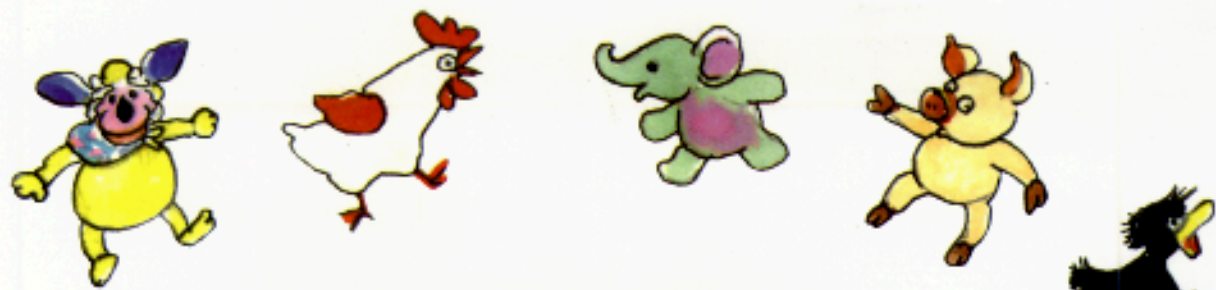
